

# Monday

## **Taekwondo with Master Joon (Grades PK4-K)**

**7 classes- \$ 315**

Join Master Joon after school for Taekwondo class! The main objective of this class is to introduce your little one to exercise and learn in a friendly, pleasant, and structured environment while prepping them for formal martial arts training. They will be learning & practicing Kukkiwon style World Taekwondo. Students will mastering kicking, blocking and punching techniques.

## **Harry Potter Club (Grades 1-5)**

**7 classes- \$ 315**

Calling all aspiring witches and wizards! Join us for this immersive class inspired by Harry's wonderful wizarding world. Each week, students study a different Hogwarts subject and complete a magical project like learning spells, owl making, and more! Weaving improv and theatre games together with arts and crafts, students use their imaginations and creativity to bring the magical series to life. By the end of the session, students will band together to solve a mystery and defeat a dark wizard using all that Harry Potter has taught them!

# Tuesday

## **Beginner Chess (PK-K)**

**9 classes- \$ 405**

This class is designed to teach primary-aged children the basic rules, moves, and strategies of chess. Children are taught through stories and visuals that help them to understand the concepts. After they are introduced to a particular strategy, children are given class time to practice.

This class is limited to 8 students

## **Advanced Beginner Chess (Grades 1-5)**

**9 classes- \$ 405**

Gather your board, pawns, rooks, and more for Chess! Children will learn about this historic game, each piece's function and more. This class requires a basic understanding of pieces and positions, while focusing on players' full understanding of the game and building strategy. Looking forward to a great class fostering sportsmanship and enthusiasm for chess!

## **Art Out of the Box! (Grades 1-3)**

**9 classes- \$ 405**

In this visual arts class, kids will learn how to get super creative and create mini masterpieces using out of the box materials like fabric, paper, and found objects from nature! They will learn about contemporary & historic artists using unconventional materials and by the end of the session, learn how to make beautiful things from unexpected items! (Grades 1 - 3)



# Wednesday

## **Gymnastics (PK4-K)** **9 classes- \$405**

This course introduces your kid to gymnastics, focusing on basic mat exercises (forward rolls, backward rolls), donkey kicks and cartwheels while improving your child's strength, balance, flexibility and coordination in a super fun, non-competitive environment.

## **Intermediate Violin- (1-5)** **9 classes- \$ 360**


In this class, we learn move forward from violin fundamentals while still focusing on proper posture and care. Focus is around use of the bow while developing the ability to produce a good sound as we draw the bow across the string. Students are encouraged to rent their own violin to keep practicing at home. Students must have taken the beginner class to move to intermediate.

## **Chess Club (Grades 2-8)** **9 classes \$432**

\*\*LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE\*\*

In our advanced tournament program will also be divided into groups according to the level of experience. We go deeper into the middle game and endgame strategies and expand into more complex tactical ideas through master games. Students discuss positional evaluations and strategies and we encourage them to share their own ideas, ask questions, and keep their thinking flexible to improve their planning and mental toughness.

Each student will receive a chess board and pieces.



# Thursday

## **Junior Legos (PK4-K)**

**8 classes- \$ 360**

With a focus on engineering, we'll help students explore science and math fundamentals through LEGO! Living in New York City, we experience some of the world's most innovative architecture just on our way to school. What better way to educate and excite our kids than by celebrating these famous buildings and their creators while fostering STEM & creative thinking skills. Join us each week as students have a blast building, testing, and exploring the world with lego!

## **LEGO Robotics (1-6)**

**8 classes- \$360**

LEGO Explorations is an introductory engineering and building program for children. Students will use Lego kits to build machines that teach principles like: gravity, potential and kinetic energy, buoyancy and density, probability, torque with gear movement, and more. Real world engineering challenges and themes are used to make projects engaging and fun!

# Friday

## **Art Out of the Box! (Grades PK-K)**

**7 classes- \$ 315**

In this visual arts class, kids will learn how to get super creative and create mini masterpieces using out of the box materials like fabric, paper, and found objects from nature! They will learn about contemporary & historic artists using unconventional materials and by the end of the session, learn how to make beautiful things from unexpected items! (Grades PK - K)

## **Taekwondo with Master Joon (Grades 1-6)**

**7 classes- \$ 315**

Join Master Joon after school on Fridays for Taekwondo class! They will be learning & practicing Kukkiwon style World Taekwondo. Students will earn belts by mastering kicking, blocking and punching techniques. At the end of the program eligible students will be able for a belt test by showing their skills and board breaking.

## **Primi Violin- Beginner (PK4/K)**

**7 classes- \$ 280**

In this class, we learn violin fundamentals, its different parts and how they function. Then, we learn proper posture and care. Because using the bow is more complex, we first learn note playing through plucking the string. Eventually we integrate the use of the bow while developing the ability to produce a good sound as we draw the bow across the string. Students continue building on the fundamentals by playing through proper exercises and songs that incorporate additional rhythms and the use of all 3 strings
